Close the Loop Ltd (CtL) collects and recycles toner cartridges and bottles, inkjet cartridges and other consumables from all printers, copiers, fax machines, and multi function devices. We have built a national collection infrastructure of over 50,000 sites including retail, government departments, corporates and small business. Retail cartridge collection points include Australia Post, Officeworks, Harvey Norman and Dick Smith. CtL is co-founder and program manager of the highly successful Cartridges 4 Planet Ark (C4PA) program and also operates cartridge collection and resource recovery programs for numerous other printer and copier OEM's.



Founded in early 2001, CtL now has operations in Somerton Victoria, and Hebron Kentucky (USA). We have pioneered the brand promise of "Zero Waste to Landfill", using this commitment to drive innovation has produced 4 patent pending technologies to extract maximum value from the processed waste and ensure that none of this complex waste stream ends up in landfill. One of our technologies is eWood®, a plastic timber material made from mixed and contaminated plastics, an inescapable output from any eWaste processing facility. You may have seen us on the ABC's New Inventors program with this innovation. Other raw materials recovered and reused include clean streams of plastic of all types, ferrous metals, non ferrous metals, precious metals, toner powder, and ink.
